Implementation Schedule


- ➤ Next Steps

 - July 10th: Interregional compliance deadline




Interregional Seams

Overview


SERTP Sponsors Overview

SIRPP



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- Southeast Interregional Participation Process
 - Interregional process among several southeastern interconnected transmission owners (outlined in each owner's Attachment K, e.g. Southern OATT Exhibit K-2)
 - Originally established to augment the Order 890 regional participation processes outlined in neighboring planning regions

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- Southeast Interregional Participation Process
 - The SERTP region's recent expansion to include five additional Sponsors encompasses the vast majority of the original SIRPP footprint
 - The SERTP provides for data exchange, evaluation, and economic planning studies among the expanded Sponsors
 - In addition, FERC Order 1000 interregional requirements satisfy the primary purpose of the SIRPP
 - Interregional Joint Evaluation, Data Exchange, & Coordination
 - FERC Order 1000 did not apply the economic planning principle to interregional planning activities
 - Therefore, SERTP Sponsors propose to replace the SIRPP with the FERC Order 1000 interregional procedures
